
SAFETY Owens Corning's commitment to safety is unconditional. The company has received the highest honor of the National Safety Council, the Green Cross for Safety medal. Since 2001, Owens Corning has reduced injuries in its facilities globally by over 90%. In addition, more than half of our facilities were injury-free in 2017. The company also expanded its Healthy Living initiatives in 2017, which promotes preventive care, healthy minds, physical activity, nutrition, being tobacco-free, and financial wellness.

DIVERSITY Embracing diversity creates an environment where employees feel welcome, respected, and valued for their contributions. Owens Corning received a

INSULATION Owens Corning delivers high-performance residential, commercial building, and industrial insulation solutions through a full line of fiberglass, foam, mineral wool, and cellular glass products and systems. These product and system solutions help conserve energy, improve acoustics, keep people safe, and ease installation and use. These qualities add up to preferred insulation products for residential, commercial construction, and industrial applications.

Owens Corning applies the principles of building science to develop safe, sustainable, durable, efficient, and affordable solutions that address thermal, air, moisture, and fire performance for the entire building envelope. These solutions range from high-

performance conditioned and ventilated attic systems to performance-engineered duct systems and wall systems designed for different climate zones.

Owens Corning is committed to helping builders, architects, and building professionals meet and exceed codes; providing comfort and energy efficiency to building occupants; and offering safe, trusted insulation systems to installers.



COMPOSITES Owens Corning is a world-leading producer of glass-fiber reinforcement materials for composites. More than 75 years ago, Owens Corning discovered commercially viable processes for making glass fibers. A composite is an engineered material system that combines reinforcement fibers, such as glass, with another material, like thermoplastic resins or gypsum. The result is a high-performance material that is more durable, energy-efficient, and lightweight than traditional materials such as steel, wood, or concrete.

Today, composite materials are found in more than 40,000 end-use applications. Owens Corning serves a diverse range of customers in the building and construction, transportation, wind energy, consumer, and industrial markets across the globe. Owens

Corning composite products deliver productivity and performance benefits, including enhanced durability, design flexibility, light-weighting (reduced fuel consumption and emissions), corrosion resistance, and more. Customers are further supported by more than 200 researchers in five research and development centers on three continents.



ROOFING Owens Corning serves the residential repair and remodeling markets, and the new construction market with its roofing systems. Owens Corning roofing shingles, underlayment, and component products help increase the roof's performance and durability. The roof has a major impact on the overall design, performance, and perceived value of a home. Owens Corning shingles offer style and color – a design for every home.

Beyond aesthetics, shingles are highly engineered products that include granules for UV protection; asphalt for weather and moisture resistance; a Fiberglas[™] mat for strength, durability and fire resistance; and advanced sealants to help them protect the roof deck from water and wind. Patented SureNail[®] Technology means that all Duration[®] Series shingles

have twice the bond strength of standard products, which helps deliver wind resistance of 130 mph*.

As part of its commitment to sustainability, Owens Corning has facilitated the recycling of 2.1 billion pounds of end-of-life shingles through our networks in 2017.
